



Payment Plan Policy and Request Form
2010-11

It is the hope of CCS that financial need would never abridge an athlete's opportunity to play competitive sports. CCS also recognizes that its decision makers have responsibility to wisely use the funds entrusted to them by parents, fans, friends and patrons of CCS.

CCS is primarily a parent/player funded organization. Families are expected to pay fees, deposits, bonds, and other expenses not later than the announced date due. When necessary, parents may request extension of due dates, provided it is in accordance with the following guidelines.

- 1. The payment plan must be in writing.
2. The plan must specify the amounts and dates that payments will be made.
3. The plan must not extend payment beyond seven calendar days prior to the day of the first scheduled game.
4. The payment plan must be presented to the CCS treasurer with partial payment not later than the original published due date.
5. Partial payment of not less than one-third (33%) of the amount due must be made at the time the payment plan is presented.
6. Payment plans are available only to CCS families who have completed the Family Registration Form and paid the annual fee in full.
7. Families using this payment plan are not eligible for early payment discounts

CCS recognizes that Providential blows may be cause for granting grace beyond the boundaries of the above policy. These are exceptions, and therefore shall be both rare and taken on a case-by-case basis.
